Grade 6-8 Electives at LMAP – Course Descriptions

Band: Playing an instrument in a band. Public performances required.

Spanish: Vocabulary, grammar and culture of Spanish speaking communities

Dance: Explore the elements of dance, performances are required.

Advanced Dance: Must have previous dance class, development of advanced techniques. performances required

AVID 7 & 8: Focus on organization, note-taking, critical thinking (*must apply and be accepted, for an application please see Mrs. McBride*)

Theatre 2: Learning the techniques and craft of theatre.

Theatre Production: LMAP Touring Theatre Company, must take Theatre 2 in the same year.

Art 1: Origins of art prehistoric through Ancient Rome.

Art 2: Art Continuum; middle ages through current art.

Choir: Vocal music with public performances.

PE (Physical Educations): Active engagement to enhance lifetime fitness habits

Music Exploration: Music appreciation, history with music-related performances.

Creative Writing: An introduction to creative writing. Students will immerse themselves in the writing process while exploring several creative writing genres.

Environmental Science: Water and air quality, energy conservation, recycling.

All Grade 6-8 Students Take*:

Foundations: This class will provide middle school students with a chance to talk about the changes occurring in their lives around issues such as relationships, bullying, harassment, online safety, and financial and college and career exploration
